HOW: The no-cost event is open to all students, their families and the community! No registration is necessary, just come and have fun—and get your health on!

The Greene County Health Department wants to make sure students and their families are set up for a healthy, successful school year and all residents have the support they need for a healthy community—Beacon of Health Improvement Opportunities and Community Support” for all ages!

“A successful school year starts with focusing on wellness for the entire family.” says Peter Powers, MD, Greene County Health Officer. Let’s start the year strong by making sure our children and their families are supported.

Free health services include school-required immunizations for children, sports physicals for school-aged children, lead level testing for children ages 1 to 6, and blood pressure, cholesterol, glucose and A1C screenings for adults, Ask the Pharmacist—medication information/review for seniors and much more! But it doesn’t stop there, school-aged children will leave with fresh haircuts and brand-new school supplies—ready to conquer the academic year. Each school-aged child that is immunized or receives a sports physical, will also receive

a new pair of school shoes—Shoe Show \$50 Pass! Each household that visits the health fair will receive a Food as Medicine \$25 gift card redeemable at the Farmers Market—providing access to fresh fruits and vegetables.

There will be free school survival kits—lunch bag, water bottle, knapsack, and school supplies while supplies last. The Greene County Ambulance Service will be on site for First Aid & CPR demonstrations, TeamWork Indiana will host fun, fast, family workouts throughout the day. There will be activities galore, games and prizes, free hot dogs, free popcorn and snow cones for all!

Need a ride to this event? Do not worry, free shuttle services are also available! Pick-up and drop-off services from each Greene County’s local school district area school to the fairgrounds and back again for your convenience. Shuttle services will be rounding every hour during the event.
