The regular meeting of the Greene County Emergency Medical Service Board was held in the Commissioners' Room of the Greene County Courthouse on July 16, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. Present in person were Ed Michael, George Dallaire, Brad Norton, and Ron Lehman. Absent was Troy Gaither. Also present in person was Director Doug Hall.

Ed Michael called the meeting to order.

The first item of business was review and approval of minutes from the June 18, 2024, regular meeting. George Dallaire moved, and Ron Lehman seconded, to waive the reading and approve the minutes as presented. Brad Norton abstained. The motion passed 3-0-1.

Director Doug Hall updated the Board as follows:

- 1. GCAS had 391 calls and 321 transports in the month of June 2024.
- 2. Revenue for June 2024 was \$229,914.32, up \$138,500.00 from last year at this time.
- 3. E1 has 187,254 miles, E2 has 268,093 miles, and E3 has 173,166 miles.
- 4. No major repairs were reported.
- 5. The new EMS facility in Linton is nearing completion. A ribbon cutting ceremony is slated for early September 2024.

There being no further business, Ron Lehman moved, and George Dallaire seconded, to adjourn. The motion passed 4-0.
