The regular meeting of the Greene County Emergency Medical Service Board was held in the Commissioners' Room of the Greene County Courthouse on October 15, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. Present in person were Ed Michael, George Dallaire, and Brad Norton. Absent were Troy Gaither and Ron Lehman. Also present, was Director Doug Hall.

Ed Michael called the meeting to order.

The first item of business was review and approval of minutes from the August 20, 2024, regular meeting. It is noted that the September 17, 2024, meeting was cancelled. Brad Norton moved, and George Dallaire seconded, to waive the reading and approve the minutes as presented. The motion passed 3-0.

Director Doug Hall updated the Board as follows:

- 1. Revenue for August 2024 was \$205,925.82 and the revenue for September 2024 was \$114,305.07.
- 2. GCAS had 354 calls and 273 transports in the month of August 2024.
- 3. GCAS had 391 calls and 292 transports in the month of September 2024
- 4. Doug reported E-2 has 283,984 miles. The grant funded replacement truck should be in this week, and possibly ready for service by early November.
- 5. No major repairs were reported.
- 6. The grant for the community paramedic has been extended through 2025.
- 7. The new Linton EMS station is nearing completion. Ed Michael noted they are working on a punch list and hope to take possession by November 1, 2024. Doug is looking into mowing and snow removal options. George Dallaire wondered if the county would be willing to plow the lot if needed.
- 8. Procol, Inc. has sold and is willing to continue to provide collection services for GCAS.

There being no further business, George Dallaire moved, and Brad Norton seconded, to adjourn. The motion passed 3-0.
